



IT INFRASTRUCTURE BRIDGING PROGRAM

Humber's IT Infrastructure Bridging Program (formerly known as the **Mobile Systems Integration** program) is a 15-week program for newcomers to Canada with education and experience in information technology, computer science or engineering (computer, electronics or electrical).

The program will help you to gain industry-specific skills in computer networking, information security, installation and configuration of servers in a virtualized environment with an emphasis on operating systems.

You will also have access to an Employment Advisor and Job Developer to ensure that you are job-ready upon graduation.

Our graduates have secured jobs as Systems Analysts, IT/Network Administrators, and Network Analysts within six months of graduation.

PROGRAM INTAKE: January, May and September

DURATION: 15 Weeks

CLASS TIMINGS: Evenings and Weekends

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Are Residents of Ontario
- Are Permanent Residents, Convention Refugees or Canadian Citizens who are eligible to work in Canada
- Have been in Canada 5 years or less
- Have educational qualifications outside of Canada with a minimum equivalency to a Canadian degree or diploma in computer science or related
- Have previous work experience outside of Canada in information technology, computer science or engineering (computer, electronics or electrical)
- Have a current Canadian Language Benchmark Assessment at a minimum Level 7/8
