



IT INFRASTRUCTURE BRIDGING PROGRAM

Humber's IT Infrastructure Bridging Program is a 15-week program for newcomers to Canada with education and experience in information technology, computer science or engineering (computer, electronics or electrical).

The program will help you to gain industry-specific skills in topics including: installation and configuration of server operating system(s), computer networking, IT security, cloud technology, and IT service management.

You will also have access to an Employment Advisor and Job Developer to ensure that you are job-ready upon graduation.

Our graduates have secured jobs as Systems Analysts, IT/Network Administrators, and Network Analysts within six months of graduation.

PROGRAM INTAKE: January, May and September

DURATION: 15 Weeks

CLASS TIMINGS: Evenings and Weekends

TUITION: Refer to website for next intake's fee

COURSES MAY INCLUDE

- Server Operating System(s)
- Computer Networking
- IT Security
- Cloud Technology
- IT Service Management

The choice of technical courses offered each intake may differ. The Career Planning course will be common in each intake.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Are Residents of Ontario
- Are Permanent Residents, Convention Refugees or Canadian Citizens who are eligible to work in Canada
- Have been in Canada 5 years or less
- Have educational qualifications outside of Canada with a minimum equivalency to a Canadian degree or diploma in computer science or related
- Have previous work experience outside of Canada in information technology, computer science or engineering (computer, electronics or electrical)
- Have a current Canadian Language Benchmark Assessment at a minimum Level 7/8
